Below is a list of supplies your child will need on their week of school beginning, Monday, August 25th. That first week, KINDERGARTEN ONLY, will have EARLY DISMISSAL. - ❖ 3 boxes of 24 count Crayola crayons (please no markers or colored pencils)
- **❖** 1 large Elmer's glue bottle
- ❖ 2 packs of sharpened *Ticonderoga pencils*
- 2 reams of 20lb paper (copy paper)
- **★** 1 K-2 *Primary Journal Composition Book* (** please look inside and make sure there is a blank area to draw and lines under to write**)
- ❖ 1 pair of headphones for computer use (put in a labeled Ziploc bag**child's name labeled on it**)
- ❖ 2 plastic two-pocket folders (no paper folders)
- ❖ 1 schoolbag
- ❖ 1 scissor
- **❖ 1** plastic pencil box
- ❖ 2 packs of Expo Dry Erase markers (Red/Blue/Purple/Orange/Green)
- ❖ 2 boxes of tissues
- **❖** 1 hand sanitizer
- **❖ 1** container of Clorox wipes

1 change of school uniform in case of emergencies – this includes **shirt, skirt/pants, underwear, and socks**. You may send in a gym uniform instead with just plain *navy blue pants and a grey shirt* but still include underwear and socks. Please put in a **gallon zip lock bag** with their name on it. All pieces need to be labeled, including the bag and turned in within the 1st week of school.

<u>Please label all of your child's belongings with his or her first and last name. This includes all jackets, sweaters, lunchboxes, schoolbag, and clothing.</u>
