Closed	GE-Reagan Foundation Scholarship Award: \$10,000 - renewable for up to 4 years Open to U.S. Citizens, minimum 3.0 GPA on a 4.0 scale; students must demonstrate leadership, drive, integrity, and citizenship.
Closed	 Taco Bell Live Mas Scholarship Submit a video (2 minutes or less in length) that answers the following questions: What is your passion and how are you currently pursuing it or planning to pursue it? How do you plan to use your passion to make your community, country, and/or world, etc. a better place? What is your education plan (education program, college, or certificate/degree program) and how will it help you pursue your passion and create a positive impact? Closed	Jackie Robinson's Foundation Scholarship Program Award: \$30,000 Applicants to this need-based scholarship are judged on their leadership skills and commitment to community service. To be considered eligible, you must identify as a minority student. The scholarships are four-year awards, and you can receive as much as \$30,000 over four years. US high school seniors are eligible to apply.



January 8 2026	Diller Teen Tikkun Olam Awards Award: \$36,000 Students must be between the ages of 13-19 and self-identify as Jewish. Students must also be currently serving in a leadership role on a project/initiative aimed at repairing the world.
January 10	SuperMoney's Financial Literacy Scholarship The program awards \$1,000 a year to a student who wants to help Americans improve their financial wellness through continued education. To qualify, students must be enrolled full-time in high school as a senior or be a part-time or full-time student in a college, graduate school, trade school, or coding bootcamp. Have a 3.0 GPA and be a citizen or permanent resident of the United States. Upload an unofficial transcript or an enrollment verification document and submit a 400-600 word essay on financial literacy.
Closed	DECA Student Scholarships Award: \$3,000 Students must be a high school senior who plans to attend college/university in 2023 and be attending a DECA member high school.
Closed	Mensa US Scholarship Award: \$2,000 Students must be enrolled in a degree program in an accredited US institution during the 2023-24 academic year. Students must complete an application and essay explaining his or her career, academic and/or vocational goals.
January 15	Sons of Norway Scholarships Award: \$4,000 Be enrolled at an accredited college, university, or high school in the United States. Be between the ages of 17 - 26 and of Norwegian descent.
Postmarked no later than January 15	Washington Crossing Foundation Scholarship Award: \$5,000 Competition open to all high school seniors who are U.S. citizens and are planning careers of service to the United States in local, state, or federal government. All awards are for one

Plan to be enrolled for at least two consecutive undergraduate terms or on track to complete an undergraduate degree within one term. Application opens January 15 2026	The Hagan Scholarship Award: \$7,500 each semester for up to 8 consecutive semesters Must be a high school graduating senior with a 3.5 cumulative GPA. DUE MARCH 15 2026
Closed	Profile in Courage High School Awards First-place: \$10,000 - Second-place: \$3,000 - Five Finalists: \$1,000 each - Ten Semi-finalists: \$100 each To be eligible you must be a United States high school student in grades 9-12 and be attending a public, private, parochial, or home school and be under the age of twenty.
Closed	Hispanic Education Endowment Fund (HEEF) Award: \$2,500 Scholarship for students of Hispanic heritage living in Orange County. Open to HS and community college students planning to enroll at a four-year university Fall 2024. The Orange County Community Foundation (OCCF) offers a wide range of scholarships for students working to make their dream of college a reality. To be considered, students must be a resident of Orange County, complete a general application and meet eligibility requirements. Over 15 scholarship opportunities available through OCCF. Must complete the online application, letter or recommendation, self-photo, and an essay describing the goal of the particular project and provide supporting documentation (no min or max word/page count). All submissions must be uploaded no later than 11:59 pm PST on the 20th of each month. The submission window closes starting the 21st and will reopen on the 1st at 8:00 a.m. Students are welcome to reapply each month. Previous winners are not eligible to reapply.
Closed	Asian & Pacific Islander American Scholarship Fund Award: \$2,500 - \$20,000 Open to U.S. citizens or Permanent Residents and of Asian and/or Pacific Islander descent. Must have a 2.7 GPA on a 4.0 scale. Recommended deadline is January 15, 2025!
Closed	Edison Scholars Program Awards: \$50,000 Must be a high school senior with at least a cumulative 3.0 GPA, plan to pursue studies in the STEM fields at a four-year accredited college or university and show financial need. Eligible STEM majors include Management Information Systems, Computer and Information Services, Engineering, Engineering Technology, Mathematics, Natural Resources and Conservation or Physical Sciences (see list of eligible majors).
