Overview

Upper Elementary English Language Arts: Reading, Writing & Grammar Foundations helps scholars strengthen the essential literacy skills needed for success across every subject. Each week focuses on a different English language arts concept, allowing scholars to strengthen foundational skills through discussion, guided practice, reading activities, and creative writing. Rather than memorizing grammar rules in isolation, scholars learn how to apply them in authentic reading and writing tasks that improve both comprehension and written communication.

A lesson on sentence structure may lead scholars to revise their own writing for greater clarity, while vocabulary and figurative language activities encourage them to make their writing more descriptive and engaging. Reading passages provide opportunities to identify main ideas,

supporting details, and key information while developing comprehension strategies that transfer across academic subjects.

✨ **What makes this class different** is its balanced approach to literacy. Grammar, reading, writing, spelling, and vocabulary are taught together so scholars understand how each skill supports stronger communication. Every lesson encourages active participation, critical thinking, creativity, and meaningful application.

Because each session explores a different skill, scholars can join the course at any time without feeling behind.
