



### **Important Dates:**

- **Senior Sunset:** Monday, June 1 at 7:30pm in the football stadium
- **Grad Practice:** Thursday, June 4 in the auditorium. Arrive by 9:45- begins promptly at 10 (**normal dress**)
- **Senior Picnic:** after grad practice and ticket distribution (details to come)
- **Graduation:** June 5 at 6 pm (**graduation attire**)

### **What is graduation attire?**

Graduation attire is either

- a. Dress shirt, long dress pants (blue, black, or khaki), and dress shoes/sandals.
- b. A dress and dress shoes
- c. Skirt, dress shirt, and dress shoes

Any of the above choices may be worn underneath the school-issued graduation gown, stole, and cap (the cap's mortarboard should be worn parallel to the ground). Only school-approved honor cords, Latin honors medals, and the school-issued gold stole will be permitted. Per ABSS policy, caps may not be decorated or adorned in any way.

### **When are tickets given out?**

Tickets will be given out immediately after graduation practice on the 4th. **Each graduate will receive 5 tickets for graduation.** This year we have one of the largest graduating classes that we have had in recent history. We understand that many of you filled out the extra ticket request form, however we are unable to offer any extra graduation tickets at this time because of space limitations. ### **Instructions for graduation**

You should arrive no later than 5:15. You will enter through the main office where administration will check you in. You can not bring in bags or cell phones. Please leave them in your vehicle or with a family member. Once you enter the building, report directly to your assigned room. You may not go to the auditorium or leave the building once you have arrived.

Family members are not allowed in the main building with you, but they may enter the auditorium at 5:15 through the auditorium lobby doors. If you have family members that need assistance, please let us know ahead of time.

Balloons and other celebratory items that will impede the view of others will not be allowed in the auditorium. Please have your family leave those items in the car.
