- 1. Create a pattern first by going to File<New 2.5 inches x 3.5 inches
- 2. File Place Embed all of the Scooby Doo Images on the canvas
- 3. Edit<Define Pattern<Scooby
- 4. File< New 2.5x3.5
- 5. Add an Adjustment Layer and choose the Scooby design. Reduce down to 50%
- 6. Flatten
- 7. **ROUND THE EDGES**: Unlock the layer. Create a layer mask (japan flag icon). Choose the rectangle tool (PATH<ROUND<Radius 300). Make sure the foreground color is set to black. Click and drag the shape from corner to corner. Right-click on the document. Selecti fill path<foreground color. Image<Adjustments<Invert.
- 8. Name it PLAYINGCARDFRONTLASTNAME
- 1. Create the **back of the card** by going to File<New 2.5x3.5
- 2. Choose the rectangle tool. Draw a rectangle. Make sure the fill is transparent (has a red line through it) and choose purple for the color of the line.
- 3. Add a clipping mask and apply the psychedelic design by holding down the option key
- 4. With the text tool, add a K to the top corner. Command J to place in a bottom corner, and command T to invert it.
- 5. File<Open the Spade icon and add it under the K. You'll want to use the eraser tool to get rid of the other shapes. If prompted to turn the layer into a smart object, say yes.
- 6. Command J to duplicate and place in the bottom corner. Then Command T to invert it.
- 7. File Place Embed Scooby
- 8. Flatten<Save a Copy
- 9. Name it Playingcardbacklastname
