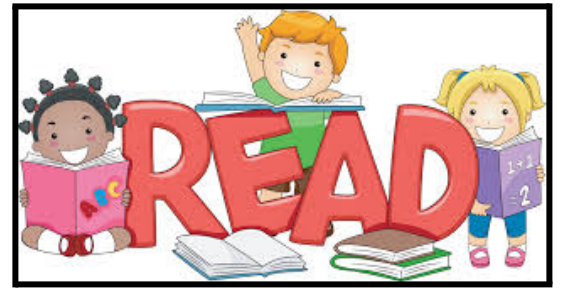


Dear Families,

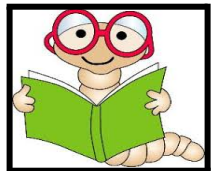


**Ways to support your child:** Read the book to your child first, have your child point to the words while you read then have your child read it back to you, have your child tell you what is going on in the pictures, discuss ways to problem solve difficult words (use a picture clue, sound out the letters, etc.), have your child act out the different parts of the book, have him or her tell you what happened in the beginning, middle, or end of the book, tell you about what he or she learned or his or her favorite part, etc. Please use the attached "How to Help Your Child with Reading Skills" list to help your child with print skills. These are the skills students will be assessed on first and need before they begin to "read".

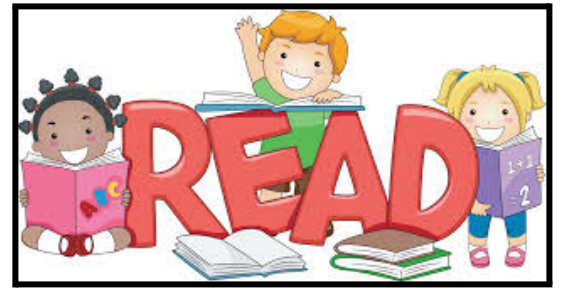
