All children will run in year groups. This is in line with the Canterbury Cross Country as it is 'year at school' grouping for 2023/24. **All children will need to have name tags with their name, year and school.** Schools are welcome to bring all year levels to the small schools cross country.

Distances:

500m Short Course – Year 1 and 2

1 Km – Years 3 and 4

2 Km – Year 5 and 6

3 Km – Year 7 and 8

Assembly:

No later than 12.15 pm in your designated school area. Your school's area will be marked with a sign. *The parking area is on the map in the Cross Country folder*

Programme

Race 1 – Yr 1 & 2

Race 2 – Yr 3 & 4

Race 3 – Yr 5 & 6

Race 4 – Yr 7/8

Depending on the conditions, we will be running with a gap in-between each race.

Courses:

Schools have been provided with a map of the course. Please look at the map carefully so you have a good understanding of the area. This map is in the Small Schools Cross Country folder.

Kowai Cross Country:

The top place getters in each year level (Year 5 to 8) will be running at the Kowai Cross Country.

Writing of Certificates: Recorders

Marshalls:

Parents are needed for marshaling, 3 from Broomfield, 1 from Waipara and 1 from Omihi. Schools to supply marshals with fluorescent vests. Marshalls are to report to the time recorders desk at 12.15 pm.

Starting Marshalls:

Competitors will be marshaled to the starting area.

Starter: “ Take your marks – set” – BANG! Starter also starts the stopwatch for each race. *Take the stopwatch to the recording desk as soon as the children have started the race. Inform the recorders of which race the stopwatch is for.*

Recorder:

Take name tags and place them on the sheets provided. Record the children's finish time next to their names.

Certificates:

Will be written and handed out on the day.

Finish line marshals:

Ensure children stay in the right order. Directing them to the recorder's table.

Spectator Duty:

Schools to be responsible for behaviour of children waiting while races are being run and ensuring that the children are marshaled into the correct race. Children are to be inside their school's allocated area while races are being run. Bins will be available, please ensure your area is tidy before you leave.

Course Marshalls:

Take a given position on course to direct runners etc. At the conclusion of the event, please **leave** all standards so they are in place for the Kowai Cross Country.

Footwear: All participants must wear suitable shoes. No spikes and no bare feet.
