

Project Display Information

- You will need to create a display to present your research project to judges.
- Typically this is a [tri fold display board](#) or a printed poster.
 - The display must be able to stand on its own.
 - If you print a poster, you will want to bring a backing board and a way to display it.
 - A great product that can be used to display a printed poster can be found on [here](#).
- The University of Nebraska Kearney provides a table that students can sit their display on.
 - Your table will be labeled with your project title and an assigned project number.
 - Below is a photo of what these tables look like.
 - There are two projects that fit each table.



- The photo below shows what the setup looks like with students on their posters.

Project Display Information



- Note there are NO chairs at your display area.
 - Be sure to wear comfortable shoes.
 - Feel free to bring a water bottle.
 - You will get a break about ½ way through the judging process.
 - You may go for some time between visits from judges.
- ISEF has specific rules for what can and cannot be displayed at your project.

- It is best to display pictures of what you did.
- Displays are **NOT ALLOWED** to have the following:
 - Electric circuits/cords--approved capacity/insulated glassware or plastic containers
 - NO reference to school or student name on display.
 - NO live animals or plants.
 - NO preserved animals, animal parts (except sealed insects) or plants.
 - NO photos/diagrams or vertebrates in abnormal positions.
 - NO human parts (except teeth, hair, histo slides).

Project Display Information

- NO soil/waste samples.
- NO chemicals (including water, lotions, soaps, etc. unless supplied by NJAS.)
- NO food.
- NO syringes.
- NO flames or flammables.
- NO items dangerous to the public (hazardous/unsafe).
- NO Class III/IV lasers.
- Adequate insulation for temperatures over 100 degrees C.
- NO open top dry cell batteries.
- Shield with ground box on high voltage--out of reach
- Shield large vacuum tubes.
- No acknowledgements are allowed on the display board.
- Displays must not exceed these dimensions:
 - Depth (front to back): 30 inches or 76 centimeters
 - Width (side to side): 48 inches or 122 centimeters
 - Height (floor to top): 108 inches or 274 centimeters
