- ❖ Post your poem whenever you like, but please post "in order" a.k.a. if you have poems to read when you open the doc, paste your work below them. We're less likely to accidentally mess with someone else's work this way.
- ❖ Put your name (or a pen name) somewhere near your poem
- ❖ Insert a page break or horizontal line after your poem
 - on the app: the plus sign on the top menu
 - on the computer: "insert" menu
