Bobcat activities

Bobcat Games Instructions

Before playing, review the Scout Law, Oath, Motto, Sign, Salute, and Handshake. Explain the significance of each (use a handbook). Then we'll split the kids into mixed age groups (up to six total groups, depending on the number of kids). If we have a large group, we'll make each of these a game to rotate to. If the group is small, we can do it all together.

1. Scout Oath Puzzle

- Simply mix up the pieces and let the kids work together to complete the puzzle. When the puzzle is finished, the entire group brings it to a leader and reads it together.

2. Scout Law Relay

- Each leader will have 12 craft sticks in a pile at their feet. Each stick has one part of the Scout Law.
- Teams line up about 15 yards away and when the game starts the first person runs to the pile of sticks, picks one, places it on the ground and runs back to tag the next person.
- As each person goes they continue to pull sticks from the pile and place them in order. Each person can correct the people before them if they think something is incorrect.
- The first relay team to get all 12 stick in order and be seated in line wins

3. Handshake, Motto, Salute, Sign Relay

- Each leader will have a cup with four coins in it. Each is labeled with Handshake, Motto, Salute, or Sign
- Teams line up about 15 yards away and when the game starts the first person runs to the sup and randomly selects a coin. If they correctly do what the coin says, they select another coin and repeat until they do all four or make a mistake.
- If they successfully complete all four they put the coins back in the cup, run back and sit down. If they are incorrect, they put the coins back in the cup and they run to the back of the line to go again.
- Continue until all Scouts have correctly responded and are seated.
- The first relay team to get all 12 stick in order and be seated in line wins

Lessons Learned

1. We did not do the puzzles. There really wasn't time, being outdoors doesn't lend itself to the activity, and there were too many kids per puzzle to be effective. These will be great for Lion/Tiger Den meetings though!
2. On the balloon stomp, we only did 1 balloon/scout. Again, this was due to time and the size of the group. I wouldn't repeat this one again for a group this size.
