

Four options exist for acquiring Read & Write for home.

Use this guide to determine which files you need to copy from the school drive to take home



OPTION 1 – Take a small file home and use it to download and install Read & Write from the Internet

- Copy the folder “Read Write 11.5 for Home Internet Install” to your personal USB drive (300 KB required).
- At home, follow the installation instructions enclosed in the folder.
- Alternatively, you can use a personal email to mail the zipped setup folder **and** instruction file or upload it to a cloud based file storage solution such as Office 365’s OneDrive, Google Drive, Dropbox, or iCloud Drive.



OPTION 2 – If you do not have high speed Internet available at home, take a larger file home and use it to install Read & Write

- Copy the folder “Read Write 11.5 for Home NO Internet Install” to your personal external USB drive (4 GB or greater).
Plan for at least 20 minutes to complete the file transfer.
- At home, follow the installation instructions enclosed in the folder.



OPTION 3 – Run Read & Write directly from a USB drive without installation on a PC

- Running Read & Write from a USB Drive allows a user to take it with them and access the program from any PC.
- Copy the folder “Read Write 11.5 for USB” onto your USB drive (4 GB or greater).
Plan for at least 20 minutes to complete the file transfer.
- To use Read & Write, open the folder and select “RWMobile.exe.”



OPTION 4 – Take a file home to use on an Apple Macintosh

- Read & Write V. 6 Mac can be copied to a USB drive to run directly from the drive or to be copied to a Mac.
- Copy the folder “Read Write Mac” onto your USB drive (4 GB or greater).
Plan for at least 20 minutes to complete the file transfer.
- At home, follow the installation instructions enclosed in the folder.
