Seeking a part-time event coordinator for MRPS PIE's Montpelier Fall Festival, happening on October 1, 2023. The expected time commitment is approximately 90 hours total from mid-April til the event day, and pay is \$2,500, with a revenue-based bonus of \$500.

Coordinator will work with the PIE board and school caregiver group leaders to:

- Manage event details, including coordinating with vendors and some communication with funders;
- Oversee festival logistics, coordinating with lead volunteers, entertainment, and other participants;
- Coordinate with and manage Fall Festival working group (all volunteer), via regular meetings (weekly after mid-August)
- Maintain clear financial tracking of revenue and expenses, using spreadsheet on shared drive
- Manage day of event, including setup and clean up (roughly 9:00 AM to 5:00 PM).

Now in its 6th year, the 2023 Montpelier Fall Festival will be TBD on the Statehouse Lawn. The Festival began in 2017 as the Kids' Cup. The original idea was to create a fundraiser that brought the community together and raised funds to support the Union Elementary School Parents Group. Over the past 5 years, the festival has grown into a large, family-friendly event with people coming from all over central Vermont. Activities have included a 1-mile fun run, kickball, gaga ball, raffles, dunk tank, carnival games, music, and, of course, food!

Thanks to generous donors and community support, the Montpelier Fall Festival has raised more than \$50,000 since 2017 to support Montpelier Roxbury Partners In Education (MRPS PIE), the umbrella 501(c)(3) of the 4 MRPS district caregiver groups. https://www.montpelierfallfestival.com/
