# Math 105Z / MTH 105Q Math in Society with Corequisite Support

#### Do you need MTH 105Z - Math in Society?

MTH 105Z satisfies the math requirement for these programs.

Anthropology, Art, Communication, Creative Writing, Early Childhood Education, English, History, Human Development & Family Studies, Journalism, Music, Political Science, Psychology, Religious Studies, Sociology, World Languages

#### What is MTH 105Q?

MTH 105Q is a 1-credit (2 hour) just in time support course designed to help you be successful in MTH 105Z Math In Society. You get extra time on assignments, extra explanations about problems, and extra support from your instructor. This can help you satisfy your math requirement in one term! Save time and money.

#### Do I need MTH 105Q?

Perhaps! Everyone taking MTH 105Z will also enroll in MTH 105Q. Exceptions:

- Students who passed MTH 098 or MTH 075 with a C or higher are not required to take MTH 105Q, but can if they want extra support.
- Students who have passed an appropriate course in high school may be eligible to take MTH 105Z without registering for MTH 105Q. Please talk to an advisor or email <a href="mathadvisor@linnbenton.edu">mathadvisor@linnbenton.edu</a> for more information.
- Students who don't think they'll need the support course should talk to a math advisor.

## How do I sign up for it?

Each 105Z section has an associated corequisite course taught by the same instructor. They are linked in Webrunner and you will be prompted to enroll in the MTH 105Q course at time of registration.

### What will we do during MTH 105Q class?

- Students will meet with an instructor 2 hours per week at the scheduled MTH 105Q class times
- Students will have extra time with the instructor for individual assistance on activities, projects, homework and concepts/topics with which MTH 105Z students typically have difficulty.
