- (1) First time at the Cleveland Convention Center
- (2) 8 Domains represented and several non-IHE additional tests
- (3) Recruited local monitors in the Cleveland area
- (4) Discount for new participants led to an increase in first time participation
- (5) Interoperability Showcase testing had 78 companies participate
- (6) **ACTION:** Joyce to provide the results to the non-IHE testing that occurred to the Board (Health Story Project, Consolidated CDA, and New Directions mobile access testing)

 - a) This is the guidance for where are the touchpoints with IHE
 - b) **ACTION:** John Donnelly will share the recent version of an issues tracker document to discuss with the DCC
 - 3. Todd Cooper stated that there is fairly decent alignment and that further coordination is needed for collaboration of projects and outreach between the two groups
 - B. Continua - update on discussions toward MOU
 - 1. Joyce stated that there has been preliminary discussion to update the MOU and this is moving forward
 - C. IHTSDO - proposed MOU terms
 - 1. renamed SNOMED
 - 2. Tentatively offer to designate a set of SNOMED codes that would be licensed freely for implementers of IHE profiles

- a) Continue with the discussion to see what codes will look like
 - b) Work to be done to establish these codes
 - c) Establish an MOU in the future
 - 3. IHE AP profiles contain SNOMED codes and this is time sensitive for a few of their profiles
 - a) Forward a timeline to Mary Kennedy/AP domain
 - b) Relationships not included and just a flat file of codes
 - c) AP would be willing to help with the SNOMED MOU development and codes
