Purpose: For those women who are pursuing their first degree, who have a gap of at least four years between high school and college (or in college attendance) who are pursuing a degree in Accounting or Finance

Criteria: Scholarship awards are presented to college students attending (full-time) an accredited college, university or professional school of accounting in the state of Montana. Candidates must have a minimum cumulative college grade point average (GPA) of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale (or the equivalent) and be majoring in accounting or finance. Scholarship candidates will be reviewed on leadership, character, communication skills, community service, extra-curricular activities, scholastic average, essay and financial need.

Term: This scholarship can only be awarded to the same individual for 3 years.

Please Note: Women in Transition scholarships are selected and awarded in May 2026 for the upcoming 2026-2027 academic school year.
