Directions: Get to know your new high school by competing in the Summer Bridge Amazing Race! In teams of 8 to 10 students and one staff member, your team must complete as many pit stops as you can in the next hour. Take one photograph at every pit stop to document your team's race around the high school. Some pit stops will require your team to complete a task; the teacher in your group will determine when your team has successfully completed each task. Prizes will be awarded to the team that successfully completes and photo-documents the most pit stops, and the team with the best/funniest/most creative team photo.

✓ Your Pit Stops	
	1. Let's hit the gym! Everyone on your team must attempt a shot from the freethrow line. Then, take a photo of your team under the basketball hoop.
	2. Batter's up! Take a photo of your team making a human pyramid out at the pitcher's mound on the baseball field.
	3. Feeling under the weather? Take a trip to the nurse's office. Take a photo of one member of your team lying on the nurse's cot.
	4. Show some school spirit! Take a photo of your team by the school's sign at the main entrance.
	5. Grab your running shoes! Make a tower out of your shoes out on the school track. Take a photo of your team gathered around your shoe tower.
	6. Don't be late! If you're late to school, you will have to check in at the main office. Take a photo with your team and someone in the main office staff.
	7. Preheat the oven to 350! Take a photo with everyone on your team wearing aprons in the cooking class.
	8. Take the stage! Take a photo of your team sitting on the edge of the stage in the school's main auditorium.
	9. School's out! Take a photo of your team jumping in the air out at the school's bus pick-up loop.
	10. Feeling hungry? Swing by the cafeteria and take a photo of your team lined up for food.
	11. Time for a swim! Take a photo of your team outside of the school's swimming pool.
	12. Let's experiment!. Take a photo of your team with everyone wearing goggles or a lab coat in a science lab.
	13. Grab a good book! Take a photo of your team seated in the library with everyone reading a book/magazine.
	14. I need help!! Go find the school counseling office and take a picture in the lobby.
