# Week of January 8th to 14th, 2023 The Chosen Season 1 Episode 1: I Have Called you By Name ~ Part 1

Suggested Preparation: <Leaders: Share this information with your group members>

- 1. Watch and reflect on the first half of <u>I Have Called you By Name</u>, up until the 28:15 timestamp. Since this episode is rather long, we have split it into two sessions. This week we will talk about the first half of the episode. Next week, we will talk about the second half.
- 2. Spend a few moments in prayer meditating on this line from Isaiah: "Thus says the Lord who created you O Jacob and he who formed you O Israel. Fear not for I have redeemed you. I have called you by name. You are mine."

## **Leader Preparation:**

- Beginning the week of January 8, 2023 and continuing until Easter Sunday we will be reflecting on the video series The Chosen. Please advise your group of this change in format.
- 2. Formed has invited two professors from the Augustine Institute to discuss The Chosen from a Catholic perspective. The discussions are interesting, but rather long. The planning team has viewed these discussions and have tried to incorporate details into the discussion questions and slides that we think might be helpful. You are welcome to view the videos for yourselves, but we do not believe it is necessary for you to do so in order to facilitate the small group discussions.

- 2. The Chosen is an artistic interpretation of scripture. Are there other religious artistic expressions that have spoken to you? A piece of art? A novel? A film? A song?
- 3. In the opening scene of the movie, Mary's father has her recall this line from Isaiah: "Thus says the Lord who created you O Jacob and he who formed you O Israel. Fear not for I have redeemed you. I have called you by name. You are mine."
  - Is there a line from scripture that you turn to in times of trial? When you are afraid?
- 4. Nicodemus is respected as the Teacher of teachers. Who are the experts in your life that you turn to for advice? Knowledge? Etc. Are there people who turn to you? How do you feel if you don't have all the answers they are looking for?
