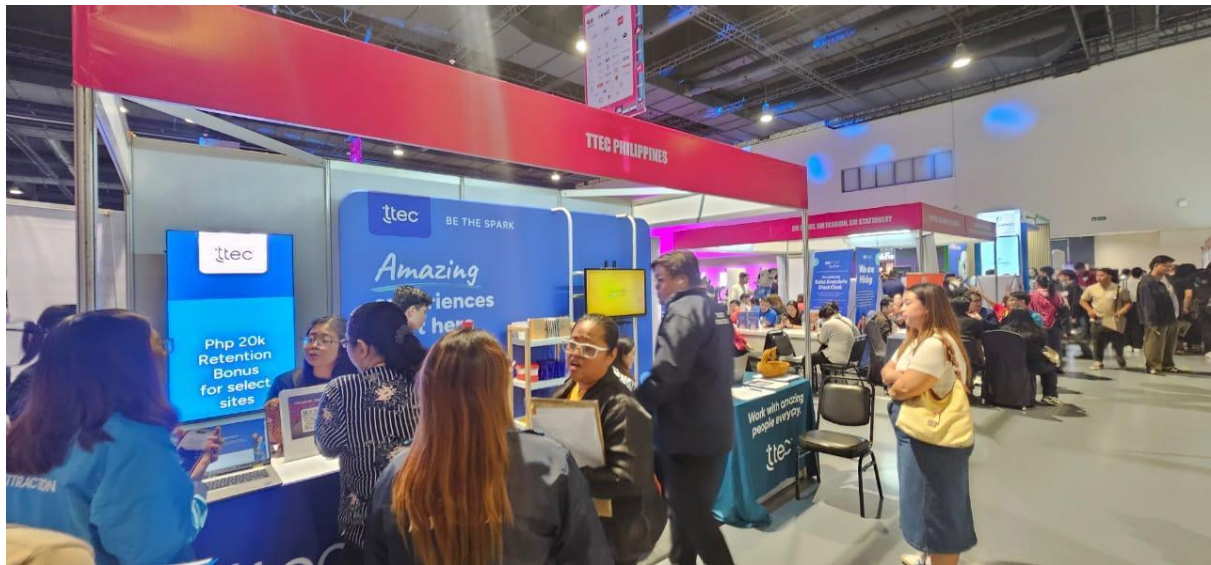
Skill Development Opportunities
