Applications must be delivered to or postmarked and mailed to Go Texan of Henderson County no later than March 2nd of the current year.

Eligibility:

The applicant must reside in Henderson County and/or attend an accredited public high school in Henderson County; must graduate by the end of the spring semester immediately following the scholarship award; must be a resident of the state of Texas and a citizen of the United States of America; must be ranked in the upper one half (1/2) of his/her graduating class; test scores must meet minimum of 950 SAT, 19 ACT, or proof of passing the TSIA in both math and English, and must enroll in a Texas college or university. There are no restrictions on major field of study.

Additional Requirements:

1. Applicant must have been an active member of your local 4-H Club or FFA Chapter in Henderson County for a minimum of three (3) of the four (4) years in high school.
2. Without this application fully completed your eligibility for a Go Texan of Henderson County scholarship may be considered nullified.
3. An awarded scholarship must be redeemed and sent to the scholarship recipient's school of choice registrar office the first year after graduating from high school.
4. Send a copy of your current high school transcript along with this application.
