Mr. Osgood will take into consideration the scores given by the Phase 1 panel members, but he will be the sole person responsible for determining which singers are invited for a full audition. Historically, approximately 40-50% of applicants have been invited for a full audition.

All audition videos will be reviewed in full by Steven Osgood. In certain instances, the stage director of one or more mainstage productions will also be asked to review audition videos.
