<u>Vector Calculus MAT226 Fall 2021</u> <u>Professor Sormani</u> Final Exam

This two hour exam has four 25-minute parts.

The Final Exam will be given during Finals Week: Wed Dec 22 at 8pm or earlier if that time has a conflict for you.

Students must complete Lessons 20-28 before taking the Final Exam. Students who have passed both midterm exams by December 5 but need more time to complete Lessons 20-28 may request an Incomplete in the course. Students with incompletes must submit Lessons 20-28 before scheduling their personal Final Exam in January.

Students with incompletes should continue forward completing two lessons per week. If you are done with Lesson 28 by a Sunday morning you may request a sample final and schedule to take the final the following Tuesday or Wednesday at 8pm depending when the professor is available.

You may only take the final after completing all the work for Lessons 20-28. When you are ready, email the professor to schedule your exam and to request a Sample Final to practice. The professor will create a googledoc:

and share editing of that document with you. At the time of your exam, we will both open your googledoc and I will place each part of your personalized exam in the document at the right time and you will have 25 minutes to complete that part with pencil and paper, and upload photos of your work. Google will keep a record of when you uploaded your photos, so do not change or move your photos after the time is up for each section. At the end of the exam you will upload selfies holding your work to prove that you completed it.

During the exam you may consult notes and online materials but may not seek assistance from other people. Keep in mind that there is very little time to spend looking things up, so it is better just to work quickly on your own. You must show all work and you must use methods taught in this course to complete the work.
