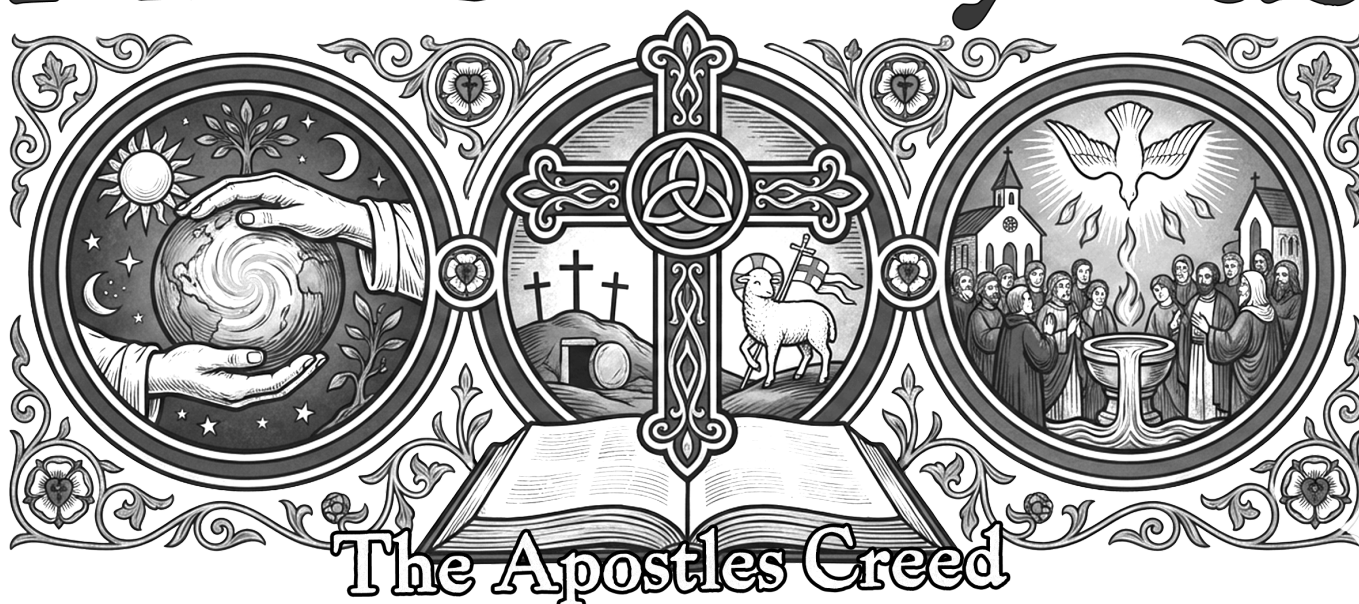

Kids at Grace

By the entrance into the sanctuary, busy bags are available for children to use. During the 10:15 service, before the sermon, Ms. Coli will take children (3 and older) to the other building for an engaging lesson about our hope in Jesus. Children are returned to their families right after the prayers. There is also a quiet room outside the sanctuary with toys and the live stream, if families need a place for younger children throughout the service.

Holy Communion

This meal is weird and wonderful: weird because we actually believe that the bread and wine are the Body and Blood of Jesus the Christ; wonderful because Jesus is with us. We take this meal very seriously here at Grace. If you have any questions or concerns, please reach out and allow us to answer your questions. **Children** who have not been instructed in the meaning of the Sacrament may come to the Lord's Table with their parents for a blessing but are asked to fold their arms across their chests to indicate they are to receive a blessing.

THE DISTRIBUTION OF THE COMMUNION: After the closing hymn, Pastor will pronounce the sending and then for those who wish to share in the celebration of communion shall remain. ***For those who have an intolerance to wine, grape juice is lighter colored on the tray, center.*** Those who find it difficult to walk to the altar can be communed at your seat. Please inform the usher of your need. After the Pastor has given your group the blessing at the altar, you may place your cup in the basket and depart from the Sanctuary down the center aisle, and enjoy fellowship in the hall.

THE HOLY GOSPEL John 3:1-17

Jesus told Nicodemus that to see the kingdom of God, one must be born again of the Spirit.

Now there was a Pharisee, a man named Nicodemus who was a member of the Jewish ruling council. He came to Jesus at night and said, "Rabbi, we know that you are a teacher who has come from God. For no one could perform the signs you are doing if God were not with him."

Jesus replied, "Very truly I tell you, no one can see the kingdom of God unless they are born again."

"How can someone be born when they are old?" Nicodemus asked. "Surely they cannot enter a second time into their mother's womb to be born!"

Jesus answered, "Very truly I tell you, no one can enter the kingdom of God unless they are born of water and the Spirit. Flesh gives birth to flesh, but the Spirit gives birth to spirit. You should not be surprised at my saying, 'You must be born again.' The wind blows wherever it pleases. You hear its sound, but you cannot tell where it comes from or where it is going. So it is with everyone born of the Spirit."

"How can this be?" Nicodemus asked.

"You are Israel's teacher," said Jesus,

“and do you not understand these things? Very truly I tell you, we speak of what we know, and we testify to what we have seen, but still you people do not accept our testimony. I have spoken to you of earthly things and you do not believe; how then will you believe if I speak of heavenly things? No one has ever gone into heaven except the one who came from heaven—the Son of Man. Just as Moses lifted up the snake in the wilderness, so the Son of Man

must be lifted up, that everyone who believes may have eternal life in him.”

For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life. For God did not send his Son into the world to condemn the world, but to save the world through him.

3. Read Ephesians 4:1-16. There is "one body and one Spirit." We often view faith as a private matter ("just me and Jesus"). What is the benefit in Spirit gathering us together as the Church as opposed to just saving us individually?

We have an extensive video program, "Earn While you Learn," which educates mothers and fathers on pregnancy, birthing, parenting and many other related topics. They earn points to purchase clothing, furniture and any additional needs. If we do not have an item, one of our donors will provide.

Through this program, moms and dads become better parents while CareNet provides baby and toddler needs. We also offer free parenting classes and have male counselors available for first time Dads and of course, any Dad!

We offer several references for adoption, open and closed.

Bottom line - we do all we can to support the mother and father as they choose life.

Cris's weekly input: Sermon Summary: Main Idea, Key Points, and Questions:

Joel 2:28-32, Ephesians 4:11-16, John 3:1-17

Pastor Cris's Summary:

We our journey through the Apostles' Creed with the Third Article: *"I believe in the Holy Spirit..."*

Martin Luther's explanation starts with a bold claim: *"I believe that I cannot by my own reason or strength believe in Jesus Christ... but the Holy Spirit has called me."*

We often treat faith as an intellectual puzzle we must solve on our own. But the story of **Nicodemus** (John 3) shows that even the smartest teacher couldn't figure it out—he needed to be "born of the Spirit."

The sermon illustrates this through personal stories of friends who couldn't force themselves to believe, but were eventually brought to faith simply by being part of the **community**. The Holy Spirit doesn't usually zap us in isolation; He works through the "Holy Christian Church." He uses ordinary things—coffee, folding chairs, awkward conversations, and service projects—to gather us into **One Body**.
