What is "Repentance"?

An Old Brit Once Described it as "About Face, Fast March"

Repentance – "Change of mind, and purpose, and life. The word here evidently means, not merely sorrow, but a forsaking of sin, and turning from it. The tendency of God's goodness and forbearance to lead people to repentance, is manifest...". ~ Barnes

In the Old Testament - Turn Back or Turn Away

In the New Testament – Think Again, Come a New Decision, and Take a New Direction

John's Gospel Doesn't Mention Repentance - So It Describes What Repentance is Instead

"Although John never uses *repent* as a verb, the verbs he *does* employ are even stronger. He teaches that <u>all true believers love the light</u> (John 3:19), <u>come to the light</u> (John 3:20-21), <u>obey the Son</u> (John 3:36), practice the truth (John 3:21), worship in spirit and truth (John 4:23-24), honor God (John 5:22-24),

do good deeds (John 5:29), eat Jesus' flesh and drink His blood (John 6:48-66), love God (John 8:42, cf. 1 John 2:15), follow Jesus (John 10:26-28), and keep Jesus' commandments (John 14:15 All of them presuppose repentance, commitment, and a desire to obey. Finally, remember that it is the Gospel of John that outlines the Holy Spirit's ministry of conviction toward the unbelieving world (John 16:8-11). Of what does the Holy Spirit convict unbelievers? Of "sin, righteousness, and judgment" [Biblia.com]

Acts 17:30 "Therefore having overlooked the times of ignorance, God is now declaring to men that all people everywhere should repent,

Repentance is God's Way of Purifying our Hearts and Lives

James 4:7-8 Submit therefore to God. Resist the devil and he will flee from you.

8 <u>Draw near to God and He will draw near to you. Cleanse your hands, you sinners; and **purify your** hearts, you double-minded.</u>

Purify My Heart

Purify My Heart; O Lord God

For the Pure in Heart, Shall See God

Holy Spirit, Come Convince My Soul; Make Me Holy and Make Me Whole.

Romans 2:4 Or do you think lightly of <u>the riches of His kindness and tolerance and patience</u>, not knowing that **the kindness of God leads you to repentance**?

1 John 1:9 If we confess our sins, He is faithful and righteous to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

This Is All About Repentance Toward God...

But, There is another Kind of Repentance for Human Relationships

Luke 17:1-4 He said to His disciples, "It is inevitable that stumbling blocks come, but woe to him through whom they come! 2 "It would be better for him if a millstone were hung around his neck and he were thrown into the sea, than that he would cause one of these little ones to stumble. 3 "Be on your guard! If your brother sins, rebuke him; and if he repents, forgive him. 4 "And if he sins against you seven times a day, and returns to you seven times, saying, 'I repent,' forgive him."

- It's God's Way of Cleaning Out Our Relationships
- Keep a Short Tab Don't have long lists of Offences that You Have not Repented of or Long Lists of Offences You Have Not Forgiven.

Repentance is a Deep Work -

2 Corinthians 7:8-11 For though I caused you sorrow by my letter, I do not regret it; though I did regret it—for I see that that letter caused you sorrow, though only for a while—9 I now rejoice, not that you were made sorrowful, but that you were made sorrowful to the point of repentance; for you were made sorrowful according to the will of God, so that you might not suffer loss in anything through us. 10 For the sorrow that is according to the will of God produces a repentance without regret, leading to salvation, but the sorrow of the world produces death. 11 For behold what earnestness this very thing, this godly sorrow, has produced in you: what vindication of yourselves, what indignation, what fear, what longing, what zeal, what avenging of wrong! In everything you demonstrated yourselves to be innocent in the matter.

<u>God Tells Everyone to Repent</u> – We Have Power to Change, We Have Conviction to Know What to Repent of, and a Mandate to Purify Our Hearts.

<u>As We Practice Repentance</u> with each Other – We Have the Opportunity to Preserve Our Relationships and for God to Do a Deep Work in Us

God's Authority Commands It - Acts 17:30

God's Kindness Leads It - Romans 2:4

God's Faithfulness Provides Forgiveness and Cleansing - 1 John 1:9

When I Realize that I Have Done Something Wrong before God or My Brothers and Sisters, The Right Response is Repentance.
