## 1. The Story Behind Dragon Bridge: A Symbol of Danang


The Dragon Bridge, inaugurated in 2013, is located in Nguyen Van Linh Street, Phuoc Ninh Ward. Hai Chau District, Danang City. It serves as a vital transportation route between the city center and Son Tra coastal area. The bridge is also near famous tourist attractions such as My Khe Beach, Bach Dang Flower Street, Han Market, and the Cham Sculpture Museum, further enhancing the city's cultural and tourism value.

The design of Dragon Bridge Danang is inspired by the image of the Ly Dynasty dragon, a sacred symbol in Vietnamese culture representing strength, power, and prosperity. Its gracefully curved body resembles the elegant and fluid movement of the legendary dragon. With its head raised high, facing the vast East Sea, the dragon exudes a majestic and powerful presence, embodying the city's relentless aspirations for growth.

The bridge spans 666 meters long and was constructed with a total investment of over 1,500 billion VND. Its state-of-the-art LED lighting system, featuring over 2,500 LED bulbs, is automatically programmed to adjust colors and brightness. From cool shades of blue to vibrant red hues, the dynamic lighting transforms the bridge into a dazzling spectacle, making it a striking highlight of the cityscape at night.

## 2. Dragon Bridge Danang Fire Show: All You Need to Know

## **Dragon Bridge fire show in Danang:**

- Days: Every Friday, Saturday, and Sunday evening
- Time: Starts at 9:00 PM, ends at approximately 9:15 PM

During the fire show, the Dragon Bridge comes to life, breathing fire continuously for about two minutes. The alternating bursts create blazing fireballs, measuring 2 - 3 meters in diameter, shooting up to 8 - 10 meters away at an angle of 15 to 45 degrees. Each fiery eruption is a thrilling moment, igniting an electrifying atmosphere and leaving the audience in awe, cheering and shouting excitedly with loud "woah"s.


During the fire performance, it breathes fire twice, with each round consisting of nine bursts, using a modern and safe fire-spraying system based on the "Dragon holding a pearl" model, where the "pearl" opens and closes as the fire erupts, creating intense and captivating moments.

In contrast, the water performance lasts for three minutes, featuring three powerful bursts that release thousands of cubic meters of mist and water droplets into the air, creating a mesmerizing haze. Adults cheer, children delight in playing with the tiny floating droplets, and photography enthusiasts eagerly capture this magical moment as light reflects off the thin veil of water, a shimmering rainbow-like effect appears, leaving spectators in awe of its enchanting beauty.

Each show lasts 10 minutes, starting at 9:00 PM every Saturday, Sunday, and on major holidays. To avoid crowds and secure the best panoramic view, visitors should arrive at least 30 minutes early. Additionally, standing at a safe distance from the bridge and positioning oneself upwind to avoid getting wet is advisable.



## 3.3. Hotel Rooftop Bars close to Dragon Bridge



## 3.4. Love Bridge and Dragon Carp Statue

#### 3.5. Han River Cruises

Purchase tickets directly at 34 Bach Dang Street, Thach Thang, Hai Chau, Danang.

Dragon Bridge spans the Han River, connecting the city center with My Khe Beach and Son Tra Peninsula, so it is easily accessible from various parts of Danang:

- From Danang International Airport (3 km, 10 minutes by car/bike): Take Nguyen Van Linh Street and head straight towards the head of the bridge. It's a direct and short drive.
- From My Khe Beach (3 km, 10 minutes by car/bike): Drive west along Vo Van Kiet Street until you reach the bridge.
- From Han Market (1.5 km, 5 minutes by car/bike): Head southeast on Tran Phu Street, then turn left onto Nguyen Van Linh Street to reach the bridge.

#### **Transportation Options:**

- Taxi/Motorbike Taxi: The most convenient way, costing around 25,000 VND 100,000 VND from the city center.
- Rental Motorbike: Available from 150,000 VND/day, offering flexibility to explore nearby attractions.

• **Walking:** If you're staying in the city center, the bridge is within walking distance of many hotels and landmarks.



## 6.1. Photography & Video

- Best angles for fire & water shots: Head to the East Side (Bach Dang Street) for a
  front view of the dragon's head, or the West Side (near Memory Lounge) for a side view
  of the dragon and the illuminated cityscape.
- Camera settings: Use night mode to capture enough light and adjust the focus for sharpness.
- Recommended equipment: A tripod is great for stabilizing during long exposures, and smartphone settings such as grid lines can help with composition.

- **Best time for photos:** Arrive 30 minutes early to set up. The best shots are just before the dragon exhales fire, capturing both the flames and the crowd's reactions.
- Waterproof gear: The water spray segment can get you wet, so protect your gear with waterproof cases or covers.
