The equipment we have in-house is limited to a passive speaker system and 2x wireless mics. We do not have any DJ decks, instruments, or monitors (the speakers that face the stage for performers).

Nothing plugs directly into our speakers. Instruments must go through the mixer, located approx 30 feet from the stage area. For your convenience and safety, we have run the following cables overhead between the stage area and the mixer: $2x \text{ XLR } - 2x \text{ 1/4}^{\text{"}} - 1x \text{ stereo RCA}$

If you require additional runs, be sure to account for the extra setup time. We recommend at least 40' cables for ground runs and at least 80' cables for ceiling runs.

You may connect your equipment to our system using XLR or 1/4". You can also use RCA, but choosing to do so will remove Bluetooth capability. DJs using RCA to our mixer should understand their deck may require a specific output setting to produce a signal through RCA.

If your performance requires multiple instruments or changes during the show, please confirm with us if you will need to bring an additional mixer. For complex shows, we highly recommend you hire a Sound Technician.

Our system has some quirks and as we are not a concert venue, we cannot guarantee every instrument will work. All guitars should bring an on-stage amp as a backup.

Speakers

subs: JBL MPro MP255S x2 (amp - Crown XLi 2500) low-mids: Peavey 3020HT x2 (amp - Peavey Deca 724) highs: Cerwin Vega V35C x2 (amp - JBL Crown XLi 1500)

2x equalizers: ART and Behringer 8-channel mixer: Alesis Multimix8

- 4 XLR inputs, 2 of which are usually occupied by the transmitter for our mics
- No AUX input you must bring an adapter to XLR male or 1/4" male

Mics: Shure wireless mic system with 2x PG58 cordless mics

- No special audio effects
- Cannot be used concurrently with another wireless mic system. If you need more than two wireless mics, you must bring in your own mic system.

Sound Check should include a quick run through of all speakers and performances and should happen BEFORE doors open.
