- Present perfect simple (page 88) HAVE + PARTICIPLE
 - + I have studied a lot; I have spoken English; He has finished homework.
 - I haven't studied much; I haven't spoken English; He hasn't finished homework.
 - ? Have you studied much? Have you spoken English? Has he finished homework?

- Present perfect with adverbs

Ever = alguna vez Have you ever gone parachuting?

Never = nunca I have <u>never</u> gone parachuting.

Already = Ya (affirmative) I have already done my homework

Yet = Ya (interrogative sentences) Have you finished your homework yet?

Todavía no (negative sentences). I haven't finished my homework yet.

Just = acabo de; I have just finished my homework.

For = durante I have studied English for eight years.

Since = desde I haven't ridden my bike since I was 10 years old.

There is a book on the table

There is some water in the kitchen

There are some / many / a lot of oranges in the kitchen

There aren't any watermelons in the kitchen

HOW MUCH + UNCOUNTABLE NOUN

HOW MANY + COUNTABLE NOUN (PLURAL)

Can: I can play the piano Can't: I can't speak Chinese

Could: I could play the piano when I was 6. Couldn't: I couldn't swim when I was 2.

Must (debo): I must study to pass the exams (obligation)

Mustn't (está prohibido): I mustn't use mobile phones in the classroom.

Should (deberías): You should go to the doctor. You are ill.
