Create a Gmail Account

- 1. Open your Internet Browser.
- 2. Search "Create Google Account" in the search bar.


4. Enter your first and last **Name** in the boxes provided.


5. Create a User Name. Google will suggest one for you. Accept Google's suggestion or make your own. The User Name you put here will become your new Email Address.


6. Next, create a **Password**. Follow Google's guidelines to ensure your password is accepted.



7.Once you have completed the form's required fields, click the **Next** button.



8.On the second page, Google asks for a **Recovery Email** or **Phone Number**. Provide this information.



9. Enter your **Birthday**. Be sure that the birth year is over 18 years ago so that your account is not created with child restrictions.




10. Enter a Gender or none, as you wish.




11. Click the **Next** button again.

13. Click on the More Options section.






- **14.** Read through this and **select** or **deselect** any options that you wish to apply or not.

1. Click on your **Current Profile Picture** (it will appear as a circle with the first letter of your name in it in the upper right corner).






2. Click on the **Camera Icon** next to your current picture in the pop up.
