- Ensure my child arrives at school refreshed and ready to learn

- Provide a fun, safe and supportive environment
- Contact parents at an early stage should any problems arise
- Motivate and engage children by providing a balanced, stimulating and well-taught curriculum
- Support home learning by setting tasks and activities as appropriate
- Keep parents informed via letters, texts and through the school website
- Encourage children to believe in themselves and feel valued
- Provide termly updates on pupil progress and attainment at Parents' Evenings and in the pupil's annual report
