Placement Exams for the Major:

- MAT 1010 will fulfill the math requirement for this major. You can register for MAT 1010 regardless of your SAT/ACT score. However, your major suggests starting your Science Inquiry (SI) in your first semester and most SI courses require a Math Placement score or exemption based on SAT/ACT scores. If your SAT/ACT MAT was less than 550/22, take the online Math Placement Test as soon as possible and prior to registering for classes.
- 2. <u>Language Placement</u> If you have experience in another language and think you can place out of the 1010 level.

First-Year Student Course Recommendations:

- 1. RC 1000 or UCO 1200 if there are seats available. If not, it's fine to take both classes in the spring semester.
- 2. Choose a General Education *Science Inquiry (SI). Enroll in one SI course.
- 3. Enroll in THR 2625
- **4.** Enroll in one of the following: **THR 2005 or THR 2009** (Try to take THR 2005 and THR 2009 during the freshman year (fall or spring). THR 2005 also counts in Humanity & Its Systems(HUM).

- All English Literary Studies (LS) designation courses have a prerequisite of RC 1000.
