VII. Risk Factors of Remaining Loosely Affiliated

1. Limited Legitimacy & Trust Issues

- Independent groups face challenges convincing donors, devotees, and interfaith bodies of credibility.
- Can be mistaken for splinter groups or “rogue” entities.

2. Vulnerability to Leadership Burnout

- Without regional and global support, local leaders shoulder **all operational, financial, and spiritual burdens**.
- Risk of instability when leadership transitions or conflicts arise.

3. Missed Opportunities

- Exclusion from ISKCON's coordinated campaigns, funding programs, and ministry support.
- Limited influence in shaping ISKCON policy or participating in regional/national decision-making.
