Lindsey put together one of the most impressive athletic careers Tremper's athletic programming has ever had. Her impact was immediate and substantial in each sport she played. Lindsey's name is a staple in the girls basketball program, and will always be considered one of the best to ever play at Tremper.

As a freshman, Lindsey earned a letter as a member of both the varsity basketball team and the varsity softball team. She led the basketball team from the moment she stepped on the court, and had a huge impact on their success. She was named captain that year, and also Team MVP; both incredible accomplishments for a freshman in high school in basketball. Her impact was not only noticed by the team, but conference wide as well. That season, Lindsey was elected to the First Team All-Conference in the Southeast Conference.

Lindsey went on to earn three more varsity letters her sophomore year in volleyball, basketball, and softball. Again, she was the basketball team's captain and Team MVP. Furthermore, she was named to the First Team All-Conference, yet again in the SEC. After her sophomore year, she earned four more varsity letters in basketball and volleyball. In total, she was a member of nine varsity rosters in her career at Tremper, and was a multi-sport captain her senior year.

Her individual accomplishments in the sport of basketball set a standard of excellence that can be matched by very few people in the history of Kenosha Unified athletics. As a four-year starter, Lindsey was team captain, and Team MVP all four years. After her Junior season, she was elected to Wisconsin's Second Team All-State, and was previously awarded All-State honorable mention both her freshman and sophomore years. Additionally, she was First Team All-Conference all four years in an extremely strong Southeast Conference. After her senior season, Lindsey was named Southeast Conference Player of the Year, and named to Wisconsin's First Team All-State.

Lindsey is eighth all-time on the Kenosha County girls high school basketball scoring list, and is the career leader in points scored for Tremper's girls basketball program at 1,305 points. In 2008, she was runner-up in Wisconsin's Miss Basketball, and was ranked as the #1 point guard in the state. She graduated in the top 15% of her class that year, and was a member of the National Honor Society.

After high school, Lindsey went on to attend Loyola University in Chicago and continued her playing career. She was a member of the women's basketball program for four years, and was a major contributor to their success. In 2010, she had an individual highlight of recording a "perfect game", shooting 100% from the field and free-throw line while recording 21 points against Niagara. She graduated with a double major in Business Administration – Sport Management and Marketing. Lindsey now works for Uline as a Senior Associate Product Manager, and is married to her husband, Michael, and they have two children. Their son Luke, is 4 years old, and their daughter, Ava, is one.
