

Please review these bullets along with the ones covered in class over the past two weeks. Use your notebooks, textbooks and the bible if needed.

- Stories used by Jesus to teach an important lesson are parables.
- Jesus said that the Kingdom of God is like a mustard seed that is planted. It grows into a large bush. We help the Kingdom of God to grow when we love others.
- One God who is Father, Son, and Holy Spirit is the Blessed Trinity.
- We believe that God is Three Divine Persons in One God.
- Stewardship is taking care of the gifts of the earth and sharing them with others.
- Vicar of Christ is the title of the Pope.
- St. Peter was the first Pope.
- The Lord's Prayer is also called the Our Father; it is in Scripture; we pray for God's Kingdom to fully come, and is prayed at every Mass.
- The Feast of the Annunciation: the angel's visit to Mary to announce that she would be the Mother of God
- We give glory to God in the prayer called the *Glory Be*.
- Parish is a community of believers who work and worship together.
- Kingdom of God begins on earth and reaches its fullness in heaven.
- The Church is the community of Jesus' followers
- College of bishops is a title for the successor of the Apostles.
- The Bishop is the leader of the diocese.
- Pope Francis is the present leader of the Catholic Church throughout the world
- Reverence is honor and respect.
- The second commandment: *You shall not take the name of the Lord your God in vain* tells us to use God's name with reverence
- The leader of the Catholic Church throughout the world is called the Pope.
- God sent Jesus to teach us how to love God, others, and ourselves.

- God is Father, Son, and Holy Spirit; always with us, love, and forgiving.
- Love is the greatest sign of a Christian community.
- The Sign of the Cross is a sign of our faith in God and shows that we are followers of Jesus.
- Jesus teaches us to love God; love your neighbor as yourself in the Great Commandment.
- Jesus' first miracle was performed at the Wedding Feast at Cana.
- A special sign that helps people to believe in God is a miracle.
- Wasting water is not an example of stewardship.
- A person who opens his or her heart to Jesus and follows Jesus' teachings is called a disciple.
- A follower of Jesus shows love for God, love for others, and respect for themselves.
