



Tardy Policy

Orr Middle School operates on an all day Tardy Lockout Policy. Each period when the tardy bell rings, teachers close their doors and direct students to the nearest location for a tardy slip. Tardiness interrupts the educational atmosphere at school. Additionally, students must learn the proper work ethic and be on time. ***Students must be in the classroom when the bell rings. Any student who is not in class will be marked tardy.***

Tardy Sweeps

- Every period, every day!
- Students who arrive with a parent note or parent sign-in will receive a pass to class.
- 4-minute passing period.
- Restrooms are closed during passing and the first/last 10 minutes of class.
- Students get a tardy pass before entering the classroom.
- Tardy carts are located in the cafeteria and the Library.

Tardy Consequences

- 1 hour after school detention. Detention is held 2:15-3:15 daily.
 - Failure to attend will result in follow-up from the Discipline Office.
