



Book Walk- Choice Reading Assignment

This summer, you had the opportunity to pick a book from a suggested list. In the first semester, we will be focusing on choice reading as we are all different types of readers. *It is the goal of Book Love to be able to share about your independent reading book but also to connect and share with other readers.* The best books challenge our beliefs by helping see through different eyes— to live a different life.

The Assignment:

- Bring a color copy of the front cover of your choice book to class.
- Answer the following questions and bring a printed copy to class. For each question, **write**

a 5 sentence minimum response.

1. Who is your main character? While you were reading this book, did any characters change? How did they change? What forces caused this change?
2. Is this character similar to any other character you've read about in another text? What are the similarities?
3. What were some of the events that created conflict in your text? What made these things happen? Why?



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4. What is the mood or tone in your text? How does the author create that mood?
 5. What new information did you learn while reading this text?
 6. How did you connect to the text? Was it personal? Was it an issue that affected your community or the world? Explain.
