### Competition Instructions

- **Please note:** There is no requirement to pre register for this competition; follow instructions below.
- This competition will feature all WCA events over a number of weekends. Whilst all times are set to AEST we welcome people from all around the world to participate. Keep checking this page for further event additions!
- All competitors should follow the [WCA Regulations](#) as far as practicable.
- Once a round opens it will be linked below under "Schedule". All finals links will take you to the Speedcubing Australia Twitch.
- Most events will have 2 rounds. Saturday (Round 1) is open to all. Sunday will feature the top 'x' competitors from Round 1 and will be hosted on the [Speedcubing Australia Twitch site](#).
- [Results](#) from round 1 will be updated regularly for everyone to see.
- Once you open the form for Round 1, type your name and unique email address. Any entries without a Full Name or Genuine Email Address will be removed. Each email address can only be used once.
- You will see the scrambles in the form linked for each event below.
- Complete each of your solves and enter the times and any penalties;
  - You can time your solves with a stackmat timer or with another timer, such as [cstimer.net](#)
  - Enter your time in the format ss.cc (as in 12.34) if it is less than a minute and m:ss.cc (as in 2:34.56) if it is over a minute
- You may only compete once in each event, competitors who register and compete more than once will have all attempts removed.
- **Please** do not discuss the scrambles publicly until the round is done at 17:00 AEST.
- **To be eligible to compete in the live streamed final (or to finish in the top 12 for events with less than 12 in the final) you will need to have video recorded your solves from Round 1 including scrambling your puzzle.** Shortly after Round 1 closes the top 12 competitors will receive an email requesting them to submit the video from Round 1, upon successful review another email will be sent with instructions for the final round to be held sometime thereafter. You are required to have access to a webcam to be able to compete in the final.

Any event where a competitor qualifies for the final but does not compete means they will only score 1 point.
