


# Map Practice - Countries, World Regions, and Other Features To Know

# 4 Level Analysis Strategy

- For any stimuli you come across in this class (map, chart, table, images) you need to utilize our 4-Layer Analysis Strategy. This will allow you to properly analyze the many forms of quantitative and qualitative data found in this class.
  - o Level 1 What is it? Read the titles, legends of all parts of the stimuli, identify scale!
  - Level 2 What do you notice? Look for patterns in the quantitative or qualitative data.
  - Level 3 What explains the patterns? Try to explain what you notice using our APHG concepts and vocabulary.

- Level 4 SPEEDS predictions? Predict what will happen regarding the patterns found.
   Try to identify possible negative and positive outcomes in applicable SPEEDS themes.
   Again, emphasize using our APHG concepts and vocabulary.
