BACKGROUND INFORMATION / PREVIOUS BOARD ACTION

Date	Action
Early 2016	Legislature passes SB 6408: An act relating to paraeducators
Early 2016	Legislature passes SB 2376: Funding \$1,750,000 of the general fund—state appropriation for fiscal year 2017 is provided solely for professional development for state-funded classroom paraeducators. OSPI allocated 9000,000 of this funding for a grant opportunity for schools to support professional development for paraeducators at the local level, and \$750,000 to develop online professional learning modules aligned with PESB Paraeducator Work Group recommendations for Paraeducator Professional Standards.
Dec 2016	OSPI contracts Education Northwest with the development of the paraeducator professional learning modules
Nov 1, 2017	"Paraeducators: What We Do Matters" modules Paraeducator Board subcommittee review

At the first Paraeducator Board meeting, members came to agreement that a subcommittee to review the modules titled "Paraeducators: What We Do Matters" was necessary. On Nov. 1, 2017, the subcommittee convened to review the modules. During this full day deliberation, reviewers provided their feedback on the content, presentation, and design of the modules. The following presentation is an overview of the review

process and a synthesis of the feedback provided.
