# Pikmin Adventure pikmin plush pattern

#### Abbreviations:

Ch = chain

Sc = single crochet

Inc = increase

Dec = decrease

Hdc = half-double crochet

Blo = back loop only $^*$ 

 $Flo = front loop only^*$ 

4tr cluster = four treble cluster (work four treble crochets up to step where you have two loops on the hook from the treble (five loops in total at the last treble) then yarn over and pull through all loops on hook)

Slst = slip stitch

Dc = double crochet

\* These are just suggestions of which side to use, if you need to work them on the other side to get it to work then by all means do so.

## You will need:

- Yellow yarn
- Black yarn
- White yarn
- Red yarn
- Blue yarn
- Green yarn
- Orange yarn
- Dark pink embroidery floss (or yarn if you're using thick yarn)
- Light green embroidery floss (or yarn if you're using thick yarn)
- Crochet hooks (one the size you use normally with your yarn for amigurumi and one a mm smaller)
- Stuffing
- A needle for assembly and embroidering the details

## Head body and stem

- 1. With red, blue or yellow (dependant on the color of Pikmin you're making) ch2 then sc 4 in ch furthest from the hook.

- 16. (Inc sc 2)×6 (24)
- 17. Sc 24
- 18. Sc 24
- 19. (Dec sc 2)×6 (18)
- 20. (Dec sc)×6 (12)
- 21. (Dec sc)×4 (8) stuff
- 22. (Dec sc 2)×2 (6)
- 23. Inc 6 (12)
- 24. Sc 12
- 25. Sc 12
- 26. Sc 12
- 27.  $(\ln c \ sc \ 5) \times 2 (14)$
- 28. Sc 14
- 29.  $(\ln c sc 6) \times 2 (16)$
- 30. Sc 16
- 31. (Inc sc 7)×2 (18) stuff
- 32. (Inc sc 2)×6 flo (24)
- 33. (Inc sc  $3)\times6$  (30) fasten off

#### **Bottom**

- 1. In black sc 18 on the unused loops on the body
- 2. (Dec sc)×6 (12) stuff
- 3. Dec 6 fasten off leaving long tail

# Sepals

1. With green ch 2 then sc 5 into furthest ch from hook

- 2. Inc 5 (10)
- 3. (In one stitch sc Hdc in the next sc) $\times$ 5 blo or flo (15)
- 4. (Sc in one stitch hdc 2 in the next sc in the next) x 5 (20) fasten off

#### Bud

- 1. With white sc 10 into the loops left from the blo/flo row of the seals
- 2. (Dec sc 3) $\times$ 2 (8)
- 3. Sc 8 stuff if possible
- 4. (Dec sc 2)×2 fasten off leaving a long tail

#### Flower

- 1. With orange ch 2 sc 5 into furthest ch from hook
- 2. Inc 5 (10)
- 3. With white (slst ch 4 4tr cluster ch 4 stitch in one stitch skip the next)×5 blo to make the petals slst to first petal fasten off

#### Leaf

- 1. With green ch 8 slst in second ch from hook sc hdc 2 sc 2 slst
- 2. On other side of starting chain slst sc2 hdc2 sc slst 2
- 3. Ch 2 slst 2 with the second on the leaf to tack down the stem fasten off leaving long tail

#### Ears

- 1. Make two with black ch 2 sc 6 in furthest ch from hook
- 2. Sc Hdc in one stitch dc hdc in next inc 4 across remaining stitches (12) fasten off
- 3. Repeat with yellow but don't fasten off, sc around both pieces fasten off leaving long tail

## Nose

- 1. In red ch 2 slst in furthest ch from hook
- 2. Chslst
- 3. Ch 2 slst fold row 1 and 2 in half and last the two sides together fasten off leaving a long tail

## Eyes

- 1. Make 2 using the smaller hook in black ch 2 sc 6 in furthest ch from hook
- 2. In white (sc Hdc in one stitch, dc hdc in the next inc)×2 (12) fasten off leaving a long tail

## **Assembly**

Sew eyes to the front of face, sew pieces shut, sew leaf/flower/bud to top of stem, embroider a light green line down center of leaf, for red pikmin sew nose a bit below eyes, for yellow pikmin sew ears on side of head for blue pikmin embroider a ^ under the eyes in dark pink.
