AS INTRODUCED

A Resolution urging the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education and the Oklahoma State Government to restore the use of equity-related terminology and student-support practices at all public higher education institutions.

- WHEREAS, restrictions on terminology such as equity, diversity, inclusion, access, and cultural competency have created confusion and barriers for Oklahoma's public colleges and universities attempting to support student success; and
- WHEREAS, these restrictions have disrupted academic programs, limited student-support initiatives, and complicated compliance with federal reporting requirements that rely on standard student-success terminology; and
- WHEREAS, Oklahoma institutions serve large populations of first-generation students, low-income students, rural students, and students with disabilities who rely on clearly defined equity-focused support services to remain enrolled and graduate; and
- WHEREAS, restoring equity-related terminology does not mandate preferential treatment or quotas, but instead enables institutions to accurately identify academic gaps, target resources, and improve student outcomes in alignment with state workforce needs; and
- WHEREAS, limiting institutions' ability to use nationally recognized student-success terminology undermines grant eligibility, accreditation processes, and transparency in student-support work.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE OKLAHOMA STUDENT GOVERNMENT ASSOCIATION THAT:

The Oklahoma Student Government Association urges the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education and the Oklahoma State Government to restore the use of equity-related terminology and allow public higher education institutions to reinstate student-support practices grounded in evidence-based equity principles.
