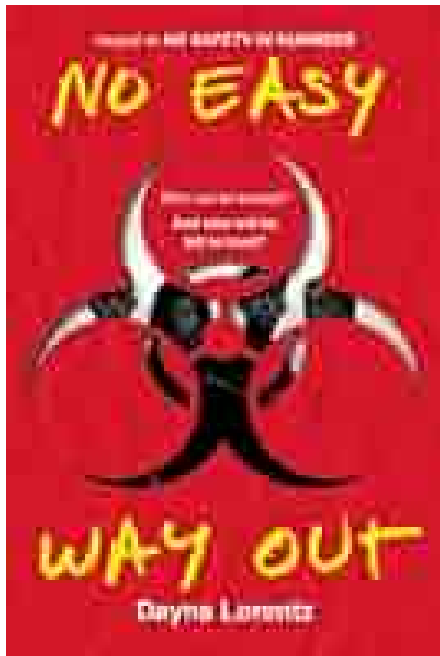


This Blog Contains Spoilers
