

Non-MHS Prom Policies & 2026

Each non-MHS student wishing to attend Prom on Saturday, May 16th must thoroughly read the policies below and sign the attached contract. **A signed contract must be turned in for a guest to purchase a Prom Ticket.**

Tickets will be on sale 4/27-5/8 in the Counseling Center with Mrs Wattles. Each ticket cost - \$125.
Checks should be made payable to MHS Student Activities.

To sit with your MHS date, submit the application to the AP Office for approval **no later than May 8th, 2026.**

5:00 pm - Arrive in Commons
5:15 pm - Begin loading buses
6:00 pm - Discovery World
6:15 pm - Dinner
7:30-10:30 pm - Dance
11:15 pm - Arrive at MHS

To attend the Mukwonago Prom, I understand that...

- 1) I must turn in a signed contract to purchase a Prom Ticket
- 2) At Prom check in, I must have a driver's license **or** student ID, **and** a valid ticket, **and** a signed contract on file
- 3) Mukwonago School District policies and consequences are enforced at Prom like all events
- 4) If I invite other students who do not have a prom ticket, my parents will be called, and any involved parties will receive a referral to AP. I must ride the bus to and from the event.
- 5) **Prom tickets are non-refundable and non-transferable (no exceptions).**
- 6) Neither I, nor my date, will dance in a way that is inappropriate for a high school event; this includes lewd dancing and behavior that includes grinding, fondling, disrobing, sexual kissing, and any behavior a chaperone deems improper or indecent. Chaperones will ask you to leave the dance floor after one warning; chaperones will contact your parent/guardian and ask them to pick you up from the dance if such behavior continues
- 7) I must adhere to the MHS Prom Dress code to enter the grand march, dinner, or dance.

Mukwonago High School Prom Dress Code:

Prom is a Formal and School-Sponsored event: dresses, dress suits, or tuxes must be worn.

-Dress Guidelines:

- Backless dresses are cut above the natural waist
- Dress length meets or exceeds 3 inches above the knee, including slits
- Neck lines are cut above the bust line
- Undergarments are covered

-Formal Tuxedos or Dress Suit Guidelines:

- Coat or vest and a tie
- Dress shoes are the appropriate footwear for gentlemen (no tennis shoes)
- Shirts must be worn at all times
- No costumes

Guest Pass Application: Non-MHS Students for MHS PROM

Must be signed by an Associate Principal's Office before May 8th, 2026
(Must be approved before a ticket can be purchased; tickets on Sale 4/27-5/8) (Prom is Saturday, May 16th)

Students bringing non-MHS guests to the Mukwonago High School Prom must abide by the following regulations:

- ◆ Submit this completed form to receive permission to buy a guest's prom ticket WITH copy of photo ID (attach)
- ◆ Student must enter and leave the dance with their guest
- ◆ Guest must show driver's license and/or photo identification for admission
- ◆ MHS students are responsible for informing their guests of all MHS behavior and dress code rules.
- ◆ Each pass is verified for accuracy. Any falsification of information and/or signatures will result in denial of Prom attendance and forfeiture of any fees paid by MHS students and guests. MHS students may receive additional disciplinary action.
