Children may engage in some of the following play experiences.

Spark: It is Netherlee's 90th Birthday Party!

Focus: 90th Birthday Decorations

The children will be using their creative and fine motor skills to create decorations for Netherlee's big day.

Spark: The children have been learning about France and asking about the Eiffel Tower.

Focus: Famous Buildings

The children will be developing their problem-solving and teamwork skills by building the Eiffel Tower and other famous buildings out of blocks.

Spark: The children have been having fun splashing in the puddles.

Focus: Rain Channels

Children will be playing with water channels and experimenting with the flow of water. They will need to work as a team and use problem solving skills to control the flow.

Spark: Children have been mark making in the nursery.

Focus: Art Outside

Children will be experimenting with mark-making by using water and 'magic' paint outside to draw.

Spark: The children have been talking about adults being 'too big' to climb into the small cosy corner Teepee.

Focus: Measurement

The children will be using different tools such a rulers and measuring tapes to compare the sizes of different objects.

Spark: We have been practising French vocabulary this week.

Focus: French Culture

Children will be learning all about French culture and researching different areas of interest, such as French food.

Spark: The children have started noticing patterns in the nursery.
