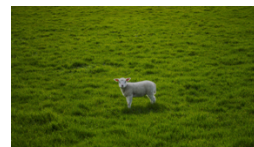
‘STUBBORN AS A MULE’ IDIOM:

“Someone who will not listen to other people’s advice and won’t change their way of doing things IS as “stubborn as a mule”

1. **God, am I stubborn?**
2. **Symptoms of a ‘stubborn spirit’:**
 - If you get angry rather than repent when confronted with the truth.
 - “Whoever stubbornly refuses to accept criticism will suddenly be broken beyond repair.” – Prov 29:1
 - You choose to fix problems on your own, instead of going to God.
 - You don’t want anything to do with God’s people.
 - You can’t control your tongue.

- Relinquish your stubborn attitude.
 - Learn to YIELD. - give way to arguments, demands, or pressure.
