

Procedure - Students on Governing Boards

A. Term of Office

DHS student body will select a Junior representative to serve two years on the board. For the first year, 2023-2024 school year, a Senior will be selected to serve a one year term. Representatives will serve beginning in June through May. After the student representatives are selected, they will receive an orientation session provided by the superintendent (or designee) and at least one member of the board of directors.

B. Qualifications

The student must be a Junior or a Senior in good standing.

C. Responsibilities

Student representatives will obey all the rules and regulations pertaining to board members. Student representatives will receive copies of all regular meeting agendas, minutes, and other relevant information, excluding executive session materials.

The board may remove a student representative during the term if he/she becomes ineligible or fails to fulfill their responsibilities. In the event a vacancy arises prior to the expiration of the term, an alternate will be appointed by the school to fill the vacancy.

Student representatives listen and participate in board meetings. For agenda items that include voting, after discussion closes but before the board votes, the chair/president turns to the student representatives and asks them to provide their advisory vote(s) of pro, con, or abstain. After taking the student advisory votes, the board takes their vote.
