In pursuance of CO Memo no. SFA /P-55/ASP/2013 dtd. 27.05.13 the following order of the competent authority regarding officiating promotion to ASP cadre from TP for a period of 11 months is issued to have immediate effect.

The following TP officers in the scale of pay of Rs. 9200-34,800/- with grade pay Rs. 4200/- (P102) are promoted to the cadre of ASP in the scale of pay of Rs. 9200-34,800/- with grade pay Rs. 4600/- (P103) purely on officiating and temporary basis for a period of 11 months or joining of the regular incumbent whichever is earlier and posted as noted against them.

Officer at serial 2 may be relieved as and when TP of 2011 batch is posted against him on completion of induction training in June 2013.

3. The above promotion of the officers is purely on temporary and officiating basis for a period of eleven (11) months or joining of the regular incumbent whichever is earlier and will not confer upon them any right or claim for regular absorption. The service rendered will not count for the purpose of fixation of seniority or continuance in the grade. This officiating arrangement will automatically cease after 11 (eleven) months from the date of joining of the officers.

4. Fetal arrangement, if any, made against the post may be terminated on assumption of duty by the officers.

5. In case any vigilance/ disc. case is pending against the officers, the promotion order should not be effected and a detailed report in this regard should be submitted to this office immediately.
