

GRADE 2 SCHOOL SUPPLY INSTRUCTIONS

Dear parents and grade two students,

I would like to welcome you and your child to the grade two classroom beginning September 2 at 8:30 a.m. It is going to be a very exciting year with so much to learn and explore!

The following is a list of school supplies and instructions to prepare for our first day of school together. To ensure that things run smoothly, it will be very important for parents to organize and label supplies as follows:

Duotangs	Write your child's name on each duotang and label as follows:
Blue	Writing x 2
Green	Reading Response
Yellow	Poetry Response
Red	Calendar
Purple	Mad Minutes
Orange	Social Studies x 2
Black	Science
White	Health
Jade	Spelling (whatever colour you have left that's blue/green) x 2
Black	Grammar
Orange	Problem of the week

Exercise Books	Write your child's name on each exercise book and label as follows:
Book 1	Journal Writing (½ Blank ½ Lined)
Book 2	How Many Ways? (½ Blank ½ Lined)

Pencil Case/Box	Write your child's name on the pencil case/box and place the following labelled items inside:
2	20g glue sticks
1	Sharpie ultra fine-point permanent black marker
24	HB pencils Staedtler (pre-sharpened)
3	White erasers – Staedtler
1	Pair of pointed scissors
1	Staedtler pencil sharpener with lid - MUST have a lid
2	Crayola 24 pencil crayons (pre-sharpened)
1	Highlighting pen

Medium Ziploc Freezer Bag	Write your child's name on each item and place them in the Ziploc Freezer Bag:
Bag 1	2 EXPO fine tip whiteboard markers (black) Small whiteboard eraser (EXPO makes a nice size)
Bag 2	Crayola washable wide tipped markers

Large Ziploc Freezer Bag	Write your child's name on each item and place them in the Ziploc Freezer Bag:
Bag 1	Small set of headphones for computer use (not earbuds), one wireless mouse with battery installed
Bag 2	30 cm. clear plastic ruler, 1 solar-powered calculator
Bag 3	Hilroy ruled loose leaf (100 sheets) and Hilroy plain looseleaf (100 sheets)

Individual Items	Write your child's name on each item and send them separately with everything listed above:
1	Non-marking running shoes (indoor shoes)
1	Box of facial tissue (126 sheets)
2	Large Ziploc freezer bags (DO NOT Label)
1	Kanga Pouch
1	Non-spill refillable water bottle

Please place all remaining school supply items from your Write-On Stationery order in a bag and keep them in a safe place at home until your child needs to replenish them.

I hope you have a wonderful summer break with plenty of time to visit family and friends, take advantage of the safe summer activities our city has to offer, and of course, curl up with a great book each day to keep those reading skills sharp.
