★ **JOINED ACTIVITIES PROPOSED FROM THE C2 STUDENTS ABOUT FURTHER PROJECT'S IMPLEMENTATION TO ALL SCHOOLS:**

1. Fb/Instagram accounts/ scme promotion.
2. Posters on the schools' walls.
3. Instagram chat for students to ask for scme help.
