 - Here's what I mean by "review":
 - Read the Latin sentence—just read it; don't figure it out at first.
 - Re-scan the sentence, and discern a basic sense of what it means.
 - ***Ask yourself: can I identify the tenses and moods of verbs, participles, gerunds, and functions of nouns?***
 - If you don't really know what it says, use your grammar knowledge to figure out the sentence until it makes some sense.
 - Write questions down that you want to ask in class.
 - Do not look at a translation!
- ☐ Translate #65, pg. 66, to *cum rēge accubuērunt* (30-40 min.)
 - Just so we're clear, the assignment must be completed according to the following format:
 - Top, right-hand corner - Name ***and*** date assignment *is turned in*
 - Heading of Paper - "Home Translation: (***Number*** & Name of Paragraph)"
 - Skip line after heading
 - ***Write the Latin neatly***, skipping lines
 - ***Parse verbs and participles***
 - ***Identify as many functions as you can*** (subject, direct object, modifier, ablative of means, etc.) and write them down
 - Write a clean translation of the prescribed section under the transcribed Latin..
 - ***Write down questions about parts of the translation you do not understand or on which you want more clarity.***
 - If you have a lot of questions, just write down 2-3 of them.
 - **Keep within the timeframe. Complete the paragraph in the time given.**
