

Elementary Course Selections

Elementary students (K-5) in FIVE will be offered the same opportunity for instruction as a traditional student. Preschool programming will not be offered in FIVE.

Additional Services offered to eligible students for K-5

FLL

Services and screenings will be offered to those students that qualify.

Reading Intervention

- Interventionists will meet with small groups either via face-to-face or through virtual learning.
- Progress monitoring will be continued based on availability of virtual resources.

Special Education and related services

- These services will be determined by the IEP team.
- Students with disabilities receiving preschool programming will need to meet with their IEP team to determine programming. Preschool is not offered in FIVE.
- Services that are offered in a traditional setting are also available in FIVE. This includes special education services, speech, OT, PT, counseling, etc.

Gifted and Talented

- AGP ELA and AGP Math will be offered..
- This will include 2nd grade students that were already placed in Escolares. These students may be taught in a third grade AGP ELA and AGP Math class or a 2nd grade Escolares class.
- Students that were placed in AGP classes, but are not state identified may receive AGP services. This will be pending enrollment.

Magnet Programs

- Magnet programming will not be offered in FIVE.
- Students will have their "seats" held for them in their Magnet/Choice program while they are enrolled in FIVE.
