Information We Collect

We Automatically Use Cookies to Learn About You

Cookies are electronic files that your computer automatically downloads when visiting our site. These cookies allow us to accurately track our web traffic by letting us know whether and when you've visited our site before, which parts of our site you're interacting with, and which sites you're coming from. It also tells us your IP address, internet browser, and your city.
